3. CFTR modulators for cystic fibrosis patients
4. Refractory Kawasaki disease and treatment
5. Management of congenital syphilis
6. Valley Fever treatment
7. RSV prevention in pediatrics
8. Treatment of neonatal herpes simplex virus infections

General Guidelines for 10 Minute Interview Presentations

Keep in mind that this is a guide for organization. You may need more than one slide for some headers/topics and not all presentations will need all these headers.

****Do not use less than size 24 font on your slides****

****Do not forget slide numbers**Maximum of 15 slides****

PREPARATION NOTES – This should be the general order and content of your slides.

- Slide 1: Title Slide
- Slide 2: Educational Objectives – This is a bulleted list of what the audience will learn
- Slide 3: Outline – How you will achieve the objectives stated
- Slide 4: Definitions – If needed
- Slide 5: Epidemiology
- Slide 6: Incidence
- Slide 7: Background - studies currently in literature that support your topic.
- Slide 8: Current Treatment Guidelines/Dosing – primary literature/supporting evidence
- Slide 9: Take Home Points (summary of the main points in the last few slides)
- Slide 10: Patient Case Examples (patient case can also be introduced after slide 4)
- Slide 11: Conclusions
