


Welcome to Valley Children's Hospital. The following pictures will show you where to go and what to expect the day of your vaccine.







Please enter through the main entrance and stop at the security desk. The officer will give you directions.





Take the elevator to the Garden Level and turn left when you see the Starbucks.





When you arrive in our registration area, you will check in.





After a little while, you will be called to a different room. You will be taken to an area like this, and two adult family members can come with you.






These are some things you may see the nurse using during your vaccine. The nurse wears gloves to keep her hands extra clean. Alcohol prep pads will be used to clean your arm. They can feel cold and wet. A Band-Aid will be used after you get your vaccine. You can ask to not have a Band-Aid if you do not want one.





You can sit with the adult you came with while you get your vaccine. You may also choose which arm to get your vaccine in.

You can also choose to sit by yourself during the vaccine.





The nurse will clean your arm with the alcohol prep pad that may feel cold and wet.





Then you will get your vaccine. Some people say it feels like a quick pinch. It's important to stay still during this part.





Next, the nurse will put the Band-Aid where you got the vaccine. The Band-Aid can come off after 15 minutes.






Great job getting your vaccine!






You will be able to get some water and pick out a snack.






You will need to sit for 15 minutes after your vaccine. You may eat your snack and drink your water during this time.
